### Advisory Council Meeting 2007-2008 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Meeting Minutes Friday, April 18, 2008

Then meeting was called to order by Jarel Whitehead.

#### Old Business:

1. Workforce program survey. Dr. Hunnicutt explained that there had still been no community use of the survey as none had been filled out since the last meeting.
  - a. He also stated that PHS wants to look into possibly transporting students to the Borger Campus for trade courses such as welding, and heating and air conditioning. This could be the stepping stone to determining what the needs of Perryton are and thus what program to begin at the Allen Campus.
2. Square Foot Program. There are 4 spaces left to complete the SFP in the conference center.

#### New Business:

1. Art Before Your Eyes. On April 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, 4 artists will be at the Allen Campus for an art show and demonstration. All Council members were invited to attend the reception Thursday night and the demonstration Friday during the day.
2. Student activities success. The Allen Campus student body has conducted 2 events that have been very successful. In March they had a St. Patrick's Day event where all wore green and ate only green foods. In April they had a HeeHaw Chili cookoff and council members Dr. Jarel Whitehead, Charlotte Hale, and Barry Willis participated as judges.
3. It was reported that the receptionist position for the campus was open and if any council member knew of a good candidate to recommend they apply.
4. SACS update. FPC will undergo SACS accreditation during the 2009-2010 academic year. Currently there are areas of noncompliance associated with the Allen Campus but the college is working diligently to address them.

5. Allen Campus Statistics. Numbers are still looking good. Dr. Hunnicutt expressed concern over the low Continuing Education numbers but said he was confident they would pick up before the end of the year.
6. Advisory Council Cookout. Dr. Hunnicutt is planning a cookout in Darrouzett for the Council for late May or early June.
7. Class Schedules were handed out to all members. Both Summer and Fall schedules.
8. Members were invited to tour the greenhouse and view all the hydroponic vegetables been grown.
